

“How to” Custom clearing account creation

Please note that all cargo being imported or exported must go through customs clearance. This process is required by law to ensure that goods comply with all applicable regulations, duties, and taxes. Without proper clearance, your container may face delays, fines, or even seizure at the port.

Customs clearance ensures a smooth and legal transit of your shipment across borders. Maersk Customs Services (MCS) and your customer experience team are here to assist you with the necessary documentation and procedures to avoid any disruptions.

For the import via Netherlands, we need the following:

- Enclosed Import instructions form needs to be filled out

From the importer we need:

- Agreement direct representation needs to be undersigned by the importer
- Agreement fiscal representation needs to be undersigned by the importer (only applicable if importer has no NL VAT number)
- Declaration of conformity needs to be undersigned by the importer as well
- Copy of the extract Chamber of Commerce (our compliance will verify if the person that undersigns is a legal representative of the importing company)
