Strike at German Seaports

Dear Customers,

We would like to provide an update on current events affecting rail operations across our network and connected seaport terminals.

Strike Action at German Seaports

The service workers' union has called a warning strike as part of ongoing collective bargaining negotiations. The strike started on **2 September 2026 at 22:00** and is expected to continue until **4 September 2026 at 22:00**.

The strike affects all seaport terminals in Hamburg, Bremerhaven and Wilhelmshaven.

Expected Operational Impact

- All import trains scheduled to depart on **3 and 4 September 2026** will be unable to operate.
- Export trains departing from inland terminals are expected to begin unloading no earlier than **Saturday**.
- The full operational impact, including alternative loading and unloading slots, is still being assessed.

Ongoing Network Impact

Due to the above circumstances, these disruptions are affecting the stability and punctuality of the rail network.

We are working continuously to minimize the impact on your shipments.
